## IMPORTANT TRANSPORTATION NOTICE

City ordinance requires all materials transported to be properly packaged to avoid spills, exposure to those who are driving and to facilitate faster unloading.

### WHAT YOU CAN BRING

#### Household Hazardous Materials

Common household chemicals such as:

- Aerosol cans
- Rechargeable and heavy metal batteries (non-alkaline)
- Fluorescent (limit 10) and LED bulbs
- Mercury items (thermometers, switches)
- Lawn and garden chemicals
- Pool chemicals
- Adhesives, glues, epoxies
- Gasoline, kerosene and flammable liquids
- Propane tanks
- Car and lead-acid batteries

#### Older (Non-Flat Screen) TVs/monitors with Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs):

- 2 per household accepted free
- Additional units \$5 each (exact cash)

#### Electronics/E-waste

Most household electronic devices are accepted free of charge, including:

- TVs and computer monitors
- Computers and laptops
- Printers and copiers
- Phones and tablets
- Video game systems
- Cables and accessories
- Small household electronics and kitchen items (mixers, blenders, etc.)

### ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT

- Paint
- Large household appliances (fridges, freezers, ovens, etc.)
- Motor oil or antifreeze
- Alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, etc.) (trash)
- Tires
- Medication or medical sharps
- Asbestos
- Smoke detectors (trash)
- Fire extinguishers
- Containers larger than 5 gallons
- Non-hazardous trash or furniture
- Ammunition and explosives

#### Accepting Residential Materials Only

No waste from businesses, farms, schools, churches or non-profit organizations.
